- **What progress have you made / What work has been completed so far?**
 - o December 18, 2019 – Protocol and ICF writing started
 - o January 21, 2020 – Protocol and ICF approved by MHRI IRB (expires January 20, 2021)
 - o March – June: Recruitment on hold due to COVID-19 pandemic
 - o May 7, 2020: First recruitment list received from Biostats and Bioinformatics
 - o July 2020: Pre-screening started
 - o August 24, 2020: First screening visit
 - o September 4, 2020: First participant enrolled
 - o September 2020: Baltimore site added
- **How has Covid-19 affected your project (lab closures, participant delays, etc.)?**
 - o Site was closed for about 3.5 months to screening visits.
 - o We continue to have slow enrollment due to COVID-19 concerns. We are recruiting patients at high risk.
- **What work is left to complete based on your original proposal?**
 - o Continue enrolling participants
 - o Close-out
 - o Data consolidation and interpretation
- **When do you realistically anticipate completing your project?**
 - o By early 2021 due to 3.5 months of site closure
